SUMMARY: The Regulation clarifies that a returned check will cause a hold to be placed on a student's account which prevents the student from receiving grades/transcripts and/or diploma and that the student will not be permitted to register in future semesters until the account has been satisfied. Technical changes have also been made to this regulation.

<u>REGULATIONS</u>RULES OF <u>THE</u> DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION DIVISION OF UNIVERSITIES UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA

<u>UF 6C1-3.002</u> Finance and Administration; University Financial Services.

(1) Students whose accounts are delinquent with the University of Florida may be denied release of transcripts, the awarding of diplomas, the granting of loans and/or registration, the use of University facilities and/or services, and admission to University functions, including Athletic Association events.

(a) Delinquency is defined as having a financial obligation to the University which has been <u>charged</u> to the student and has not been <u>satisfied</u> by the established due date.

(2) A student may not be granted a loan through the University's student financial aid system when:

(a) The student is not currently enrolled;

(b) The student's history with the University reveals that the student on more than one occasion failed to repay prior loans within eleven to thirty (30) days after due date, or on one (1) occasion failed to make the required payment within thirty-one (31) days after the due date.

(3) When a <u>student check written by a University of Florida student</u> is returned uncollected and is not redeemed within seven days, it is considered to be a delinquent account with the University and <u>a hold will be placed on the student's account which prevents the student</u> <u>from receiving grades, transcripts and/or diploma and the student's registration will be denied for</u> <u>future terms</u>the student's academic progress will be suspended and no transcripts will be released or diplomas awarded to the student until the account has been paid in full.
